

# Variables in Community Writing Center Work or The Smorgasbord from which Project Types Develop

<b>Who we are</b>	tutors/consultants trained in an academic writing center, working simultaneously in their home center and in the community
	tutors/consultants trained in an academic writing center working solely in the community
	tutors/consultants are community members without prior writing center experience trained to work with other community members
<b>Where we work</b>	community writing services are housed in an academic setting
	community writing services are housed in a community setting that is open to the public such as a library, community center, church
	community writing services are housed in a community setting that is not open to the public, such as a public school or a non-profit
<b>With whom we work</b>	tutors/consultants work with any community member
	tutors/consultants work with staff and/or clients of a specific community partner, such as a school or non-profit or for-profit
	tutors/consultants partner with other campus programs, service learning or other, that are collaborating with community partners
<b>How we work</b>	tutors/consultants primarily conduct one-on-one consultations
	tutors/consultants primarily conduct workshops or facilitate writing groups
	tutors/consultants as volunteers/students in Service Learning courses
